RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN FORSYTH COUNTY AND THE NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO FUND AUTHORIZED OPERATIONAL EXPENSES AT SMITH REYNOLDS AIRPORT (AIRPORT DEPARTMENT)

WHEREAS Forsyth County owns and operates Smith Reynolds Airport, and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) distributes funds from the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in the form of grants;

WHEREAS the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (H.R. 748, Public Law 116-136), signed into law by the President on March 27, 2020, includes \$100 million in funds to be awarded as economic relief to eligible United States general aviation airports affected by the prevention of, preparation for, and response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS the NCDOT has received CARES Act funding and has awarded Forsyth County a grant, to be applied to operational expenses such as the Airport Department's payroll, in the amount of \$157,000, based on the airport's FAA-designated category of a National General Aviation Airport, subject to the conditions and limitations of the Grant Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that the Chairman or County Manager and the Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the above-described Grant Agreement, with the North Carolina Department of Transportation, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to the form and legality by the County Attorney.
