NC 4-H Photography Contest

All entries must be submitted digitally by emailing BOTH rebecca kirkland@ncsu.edu AND april bowman@ncsu.edu with the words "NC 4-H Photo Contest 2012" in the subject line or postmarked NO LATER THAN June 8, 2012. Failure to email entries to Mrs. April means that you will NOT earn County Scholarship dollars for participating. Failure to email entries to Ms. Rebecca means that you will not be eligible to compete for state prizes. You may send one email containing all three pictures. Youth ages 5-8 should email ONLY Mrs. April.

- The state contest is open to (and only to) all North Carolina 4-H members ages 9-19.
- All entry photos must have been taken by the 4-H'er submitting the entry during the contest year.
- Each entrant may submit only one photo in each of the three categories: "4-H in Action", "Nature's
 Beauty" and "Lines" (examples include: lines of people to lines of corn; veins on a leaf or lines of
 tractors, pieces of fabric or railroad tracks receding on the horizon and originality counts). This means
 that each individual 4-H'er may have as many as three entries so long as they submit each entry in a
 different category.
- The same image may be entered in more than one category (if it applies to each category).
- Please attach an Entry Form to the email containing your photographs.
- Photos may be in color OR black-and-white.

Please, please send your entries at the highest image resolution possible so that we may make high-quality display prints of the winners.

4-H Dairy Poster Contest

The 4-H Dairy Poster contest theme is "Dedicated to Dairy-Make Mine Milk". Entries must be submitted to Forsyth County 4-H by July 9th. More information can be found at http://www.cals.ncsu.edu/an_sci/extension/dairy/4-H/Poster%20Contest/2012/2012%20DAIRY%20POSTER%20CONTEST.doc as well as the entry form (score card) that must be attached to the back of every entry. The rules are very similar to the beef poster rules (see page 3). First prize for the state in each age division 9-12, 13-15 and 16-19 is \$100, second \$75 and third \$50 (courtesy of the Southeastern United Dairy Industry Association) so start drawing!

(There will NOT be a career or poultry poster contest this year.)

JBRU BEEF POSTER AND PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST

The purposes of the "JBRU Beef Poster and Photography Contests" are to allow youth an opportunity to expand into the area of marketing which is a vital step between the producer and consumer. The Contest will include divisions for youth that have reached their 5th birthday and have not reached his/her 22nd birthday as of January 1, 2012. This contest also provides the participants a way to enhance their creativity and originality, as well as, a way to share their ideas with other youth and public.

POSTER CONTEST GUIDELINES

- 1. In order to compete in this contest, all work must be conducted on an individual basis (all work must done by the entrant). There will be 4 divisions: Division I (6-8 years of age), Division II (9-11 years of age), Division III (12-15 years of age), and Division IV (16-21 years of age).
- 2. Poster dimensions must be standard poster board size (22" X 28).
- 3. Create an advertisement or promotional piece suitable for placing in a publication or handout. The theme of the poster should be "Team Beef, Fuel for the finish", please check the National Cattlemen's Beef Association for additional information. Specific breed promotion is not accepted as promotion of the industry image.
- 4. Posters may not contain copyrighted material such as cartoon characters, etc.
- 5. There is no limit as to the use of style of drawing or lettering, provided they are the design and handiwork of the entrants. Photographs, magazine clippings, stencils and adhesive letters may be used.
- 6. It is suggested (but not required) that posters be laminated or covered with clear contact paper. When being submitted for competition each poster must be accompanied by the poster score card, with the top portion completely filled out and taped to the backside of the poster.

PHOTOGRAPHY CONTEST GUIDELINES

1. In order to compete in this contest, all work must be conducted on an individual basis (all work must done by the entrant). There will be 4 divisions: Division I (6-8 years of age), Division II (9-11 years of age), Division III (12-15 years of age), and Division IV

(16-21 years of age) as of January 1, 2012. Youth will be ranked using the Danish System and an overall winner will be declared for each division.

- 2. There will be three categories:
- a.Landscape Photographs that focus on scenery around the farm or ranch should be the main focus of the picture.
- b.Animals Photographs that highlight cattle on the farm or at an event. The cattle should be the dominant focus of the picture.
- c.People Photographs that show youth and/or family, friends, etc., either involved in activities on the farm, ranch or at an event.
- 3. Photo size may be 5x7" or 8x10" and mounted on a stiff backing with no matting or frame.
- 4. Photo entries must not have competed in any other JBRU photography contest.
- 5. The photo entry must have been taken during the last year. The photo cannot be altered or image enhanced in any way.
- 6. Maximum of three entries per contestant. No more than 1 entry per category.
- 7. When being submitted for competition each photo must be accompanied by the photo score card, with the top portion completely filled out and taped to the backside of the poster.
- 8. Photographs are to be submitted to the Forsyth County 4-H office by 4 PM, Thursday May 31st (earlier is PREFERRED).
