YA Bacigalupi *The Doubt Factory* by Paolo Bacigalupi

Alix's life swerves into danger when she starts to distrust her dad, whose PR business defends clients producing harmful and lethal products. Should she trust her new stalker? Discovering what's true creates ever-more peril.

YA Hiassen *Skink—-No Surrender* by Carl Hiassen
