Observations and Corrective Actions

Violations cited in this report must be corrected within the time frames below, or as stated in sections 8-405.11 of the food code.

- 11 3-202.15 Package Integrity - PF Two cans of pizza sauce were badly dented on the rims and on the side of the cans. All canned food shall be intact and in good condition, cans dented on the rims or middle seam and cans that have severe dents shall be removed from general food stock and disposed of or returned to supplier. CDI: Person in charge stated a policy of removing dented cans when found and setting them aside on an adjacent shelf for return. PIC removed the two cans and segregated them from the general supply. CDI.
- 45 4-501.11 Good Repair and Proper Adjustment-Equipment - C Repeat: long screw threads exposed on the underside of the vegetable slicer table. Any exposed screw threads shall be cut or covered in a cleanable sleeve to promote cleanability. Cut or cap the exposed screw threads. // Professionally weld and polish smooth the cracks that have formed on the corners of the wash and sanitizer basins at the three compartment sink. Cracks on sink basins are a catch point for food and bacteria and are not easily cleanable, sink basins shall be in good repair. Repair the cracks in the three compartment sink.
- 52 5-501.114 Using Drain Plugs - C Dumpster drain plugs are missing from the waste and recycle dumpsters. All dumpsters with a drain hole shall be supplied with a drain plug. Replace missing drain plugs.

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- 53 6-201.13 Floor and Wall Junctures, Coved, and Enclosed or Sealed - C Seal where the hot water heater pipes enter the ceiling. All entry points into walls and ceilings shall be sealed. // 6-201.11 Floors, Walls and Ceilings-Cleanability - C FRP panelling where the shelf is attached in the restroom is starting to pull away from the wall. Ensure that all FRP panels are properly attached to the wall.
- 54 6-303.11 Intensity-Lighting - C Lighting is low in the employee restroom (8-9 ft-cl) Lighting in restrooms shall be provided at 20 foot candles. Increase the lighting in the restroom.
