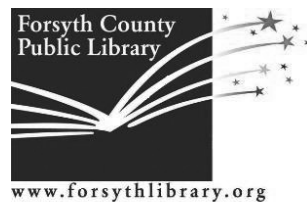

Describes the historical circumstances that led to ships sinking and being lost, such as the Titanic and the Civil War submarine H.L. Hunley plus the archaeological discoveries that found evidence of and preserved these shipwrecks.

JB Close **Face Book** by **Chuck Close**
Presents an autobiography about the author's artistic life, describing the creative processes he uses in the studio and his struggles with his disabilities. Includes a self-portrait mix-and-match section that demonstrates his techniques and images.

JB Dave **Etched in Clay: The Life of Dave, Enslaved Potter and Poet** by **Andrea Cheng**
Born into slavery, Dave becomes a master potter and, despite laws forbidding slave literacy, learns to read and write. This biography chronicles his life in a series of poems, including verses Dave etched onto the pottery he created.
