

**RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR AN AUDIO/VISUAL SYSTEM
FOR THE FORSYTH COUNTY CENTRAL LIBRARY
(GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND
CITY/COUNTY PURCHASING DEPARTMENT)**

WHEREAS, after due advertisement, bids were received and publicly opened by the City/County Purchasing Department at 9:00 a.m. on September 20, 2016, for a turn-key audio/visual system to provide all equipment, labor, installation materials, programming, testing, training, and follow-up support meeting detailed specifications at the Forsyth County Central Library and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the County Manager, General Services Director, the Purchasing Director that a contract for a turn-key audio/visual system for the Forsyth County Central Library meeting bid specifications be awarded to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, Onepath Systems of NC, LLC in the amount of \$548,161.46; and

WHEREAS, the County Chief Financial Officer has determined that sufficient funds are available to cover the cost of this contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners that a contract for a turn-key audio/visual system, including equipment, labor, installation materials, programming, testing, training, and follow-up support for the Forsyth County Central Library, meeting bid specifications in the amount of \$548,161.46, is hereby awarded to Onepath Systems of NC, LLC and that all other bids are hereby rejected.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Manager and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, a contract for a turn-key audio/visual system meeting bid specifications in the amount of \$548,161.46 for the Forsyth County Central Library, as identified herein with Onepath Systems of NC, LLC, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, where applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
