Such programs will serve the behavioral health needs of children and adults for the fiscal year 2021-2022 beginning July 1, 2021. The use of these funds requires an agency match in the amount specified above. The match may be in-kind or cash or both.

Behavioral Health includes: Mental Health, Substance Use, and Developmental Disabilities.

The County will consider proposals for programs related to the following:

3. Program services reflect innovation, if applicable.
4. Program services reflect collaboration and identify partners addressing the needs of the consumer.

Local public agencies and 501(c)(3) non-profit corporations are invited to submit applications to provide services addressing the priorities above. Private non-profits are also required to submit proof of 501(c)(3) status.
