Dear Mr. Phogbound:

This letter is notice that you are required by Chapter 3 of the Forsyth County Air Quality Technical Code, Subchapter 3Q, Rule .0207 and Subchapter 3D, Rule .0202 to quantify your facility's calendar year 2017 air pollutant emissions and report those emissions data to the Forsyth County Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection. Emissions inventory data are utilized in air quality planning, toxic risk assessment, determination of permit fees, satisfaction of Federal emission reporting requirements and other related purposes. Using the enclosed forms and instructions, you are required to provide your best estimate of actual emissions of each regulated pollutant from all sources of emissions at your facility. The forms are also available in Excel spreadsheet format on the Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection's website (see enclosed instructions). Please complete and return your emission inventory to this Office by **June 30, 2018**.

As an alternate to the forms, your emissions inventory may be submitted in digital format via a database obtained from the Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection. You must have Microsoft Access 2003 or higher installed on your computer to take advantage of this method. To request a copy of the database, email me at [lydask@forsyth.cc](mailto:lydask@forsyth.cc). If your inventory was previously submitted via database, please do not re-use it. You must obtain the latest version of the emission inventory database in order to receive the benefit of quality assured data and updated code tables.

If you need assistance with estimating your facility's emissions, you are encouraged to contact your case manager at the Office of Environmental Assistance and Protection at 336-703-2440. Your case manager is familiar with your facility's processes and will be able to provide guidance and assistance with calculating emissions as well as help identify additional information you may need to bring to your appointment should you request a meeting.
