Call To Order

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 PM.

Approval of Absentees

There were 4215 absentees recommended for approval and 54 recommended for disapproval. There were 3 ballots the Board requested to be researched since voter signatures were in the wrong place. Mr. Elliott suggested checking to see if their signatures were on file. After researching these, the signatures were found to be on file. Mr. Elliott moved to approve CIV 1629, CIV 1883 and CIV 2227. Ms. Sutton seconded the motion and it passed 2-1. Ms. Sutton moved to approve 4218 absentees and disapprove 51. Mr. Jordan seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

The Board and Staff opened and sorted the absentee ballots in preparation for counting.

CIV 774 was previously approved but the ballot is not in the envelope. The Ballot was discovered in the envelope of CIV 774, which was the spouse's envelope. The Board decided to count the ballot.

Mrs. Speas showed the Board ballots that had been faxed by military

and overseas voters. The votes will have to be marked on paper ballots in order to be counted. The ones to be marked are CIV 1022, CIV 2460, CIV 2461, CIV 2589, CIV 2752, MIL 315, OVR 19 and OVR 30. The Staff marked the ballots and the Board reviewed them.

At 7:15 the absentee ballots were run through the ballot counter. There are 13 curbside ballots from one-stop that Board agreed to add to the absentee ballots to be counted.

The Board concluded the count of the ballots at 8:00 PM.
