Tanglewood Stables

Did you know Tanglewood Stables has plenty to offer all year round? Tanglewood Stables offers trail rides, group or private riding lessons, and seasonal hayrides and carriage rides. Reservations are recommended for all stable activities.

Tanglewood Stables also offers boarding for privately owned horses. The horses thrive in the 28+ acres pasture, which allow for plenty of interaction with other horses or alone time. Hay, water, and grain is provided daily, along with clean stalls.

The trail rides are one of the best ways to see
Tanglewood Park. No riding experience is required to
participate in a trail ride. The stables staff will match
each rider with a suitable horse and guide each group
along wooded paths and trails along the Yadkin River.
You will often see birds, deer, and other park wildlife on
these trail rides.
