Tanglewood Park RV Campground Opening

The Tanglewood Park RV Campground is back open! The 2025 campground season is from March 1st - December 5th. There are 44 sites, and each site has full hookup with 20/30/50 amp plug in. The campground also features a volleyball court, horseshoe pits, small soccer field, fire pits, and a picnic shelter available for reservation.

Come enjoy Tanglewood Park from a different experience by staying on site. There are plenty of activities to do at the park and around the Clemmons area. Walk the miles of paved or natural surface trails, play a round of golf at one of our courses, or visit our Aquatic Center (Memorial Day-Labor Day).

Tanglewood Golf

Tanglewood Park is home to many activities for all to enjoy. With Spring right around the corner, one of these is Golf! Tanglewood has two 18-hole championship courses, an 18-hole par 3 course, two driving ranges, a practice putting green, and chipping green.

If you are looking to feel some history while you play, the Championship Course is for you. Home to the 1974 PGA Championship and several Senior PGA Tour events, this course has been played by many of golf's greats! Including Jack Nicklaus and Lee Trevino.

If you are looking for a challenging layout, the Reynolds Course will certainly offer that. Considered one of the best value courses around, this course carves through the woods of Tanglewood Park and features plenty of elevation change.
