Pesticide Safety School is intended for people who wish to obtain a North Carolina pesticide applicator license. A NC pesticide license is required for applicators who are applying pesticides for pay or anyone using restricted-use chemicals. Please visit pesticidesafety.ces.ncsu.edu for more information about pesticide schools, including a schedule for upcoming Pesticide Schools.

Pesticide school lasts 1 ½ days, starting at 8:30 AM each day. Please arrive early if you need to register for the school. You can pre-register for the school and order manuals online at <u>pesticidemanuals.com</u>. It is recommended that you order manuals early so you can review them before the school. Please allow at least two weeks for the manuals to arrive. Click here for the manual order form if you prefer to order by mail.

The pesticide exams will be held at 1:00 PM on the second day of the school, Pesticide exams are administered by NCDA and exam registration must be completed separately from registration for pesticide school. To pre-register for the exams, <u>click here</u>.

Pesticide school is hosted by the NC State Pesticide Safety Education Program with the help of N.C. Cooperative Extension and the North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (NCDA&CS).
