## **Summary of Approved Activities**

Clemmons Food Pantry (CFP) was awarded \$25,000 in ARPA funds to be used for general operating expenses such as mortgage, utilities, and maintenance, as well as, for the wholesale purchase of fresh food, produce and canned goods. The grant will ensure the Clemmons Food Pantry remains a solid community support program serving individuals at or below the Federal poverty level.

- 307,731 Pounds of Food Distributed
- **1884** Average Individuals Served Monthly
- 532 Average Households Served Monthly
- 17% Clients access food using CFP alternative modes of service monthly to avoid spread of Covid-19 (pre-packaged, online, curbside vs. client-select)
- 5 partner agencies receiving food to increase hunger relief and decrease food loss
