Summary of Approved Activities

Forsyth County Government has approved ARPA funding for Senior Services Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 to construct a new Intergenerational Center for Arts and Wellness facility in Forsyth County. The facility will include a new and expanded Williams Adult Day Center that will meet the daily needs of older adults who are living with Alzheimer's and other forms of dementia and a day program that will bring health, wellness, arts, and intergenerational program partners under one roof.

Construction of the new building will be measured by design & construction milestones and are listed below.



Results:

- **May 2022** - Design completed.
- **November 2022** - Builder under contract.
- **July 2023** - Building under construction.
- **September 2023** - Construction complete.
- **October 26, 2023** - Building placed into service.
- **November 17, 2023** - Open House at 11am.
- **April 2024** – All dedicated space partners have moved in and programming is available to the community.

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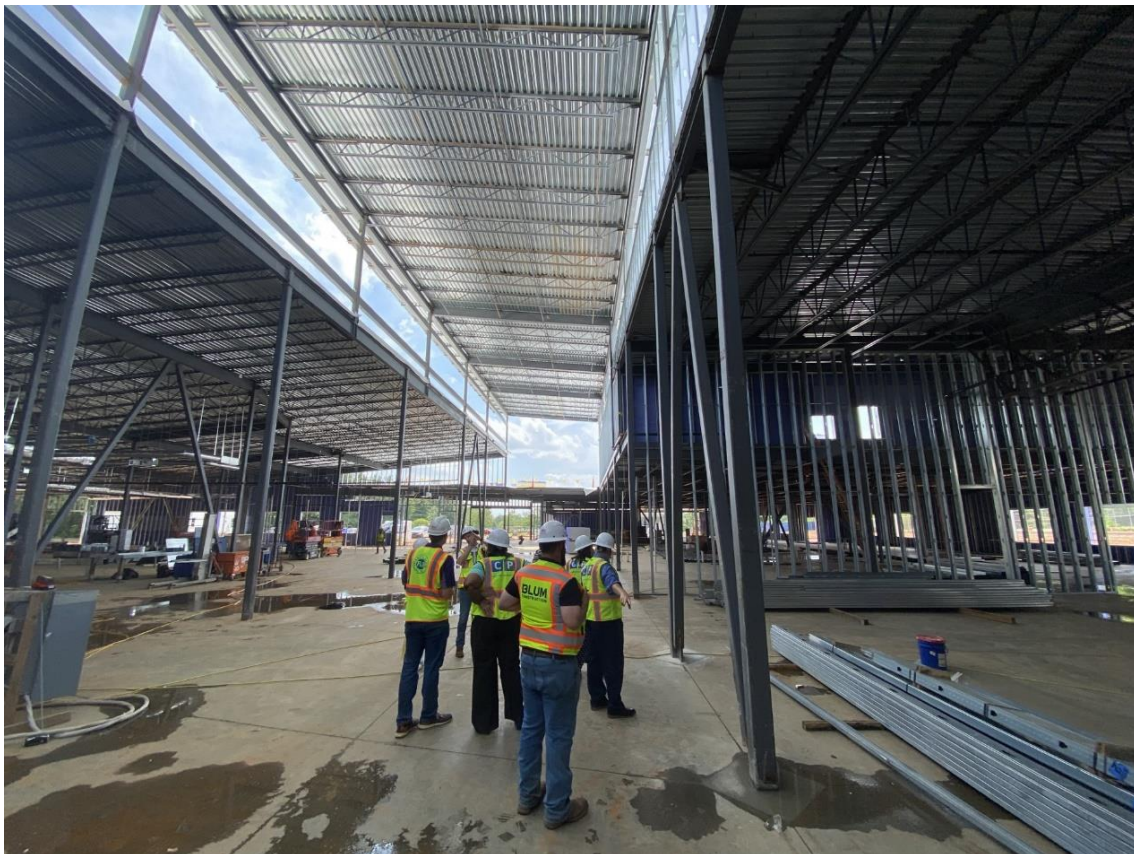

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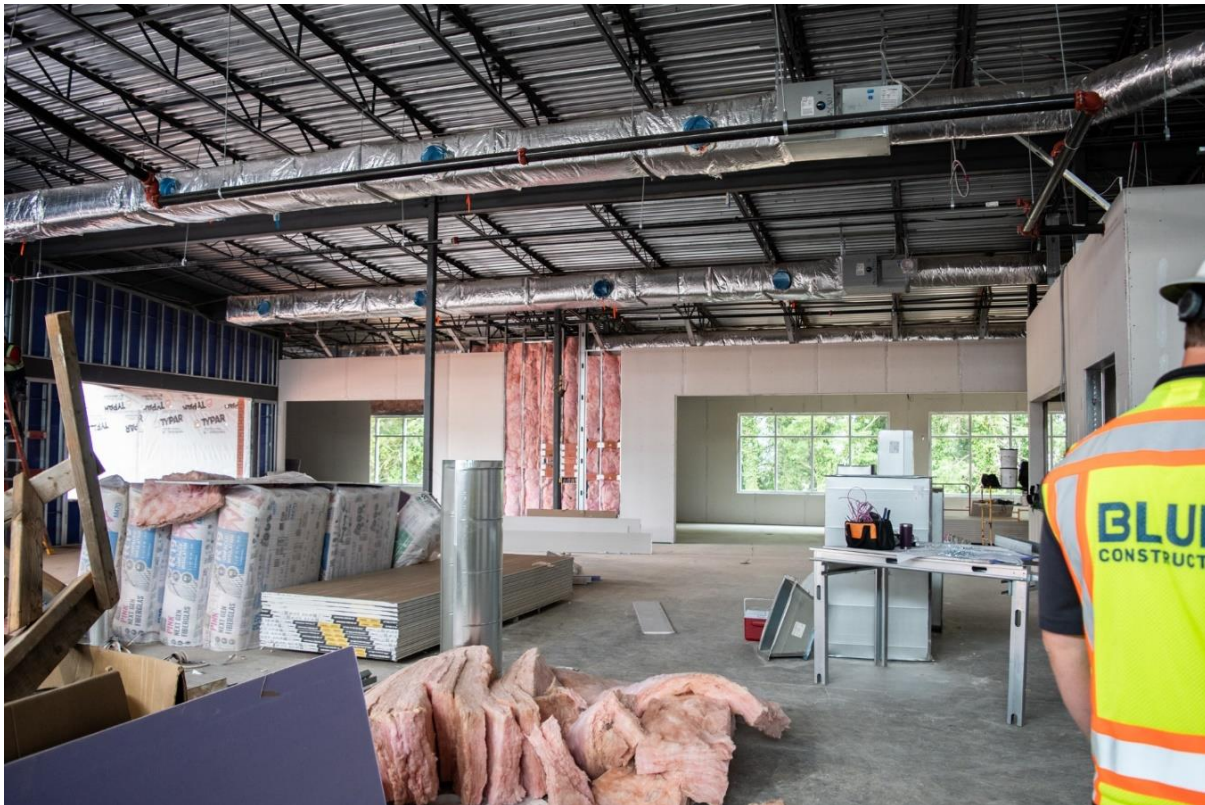
