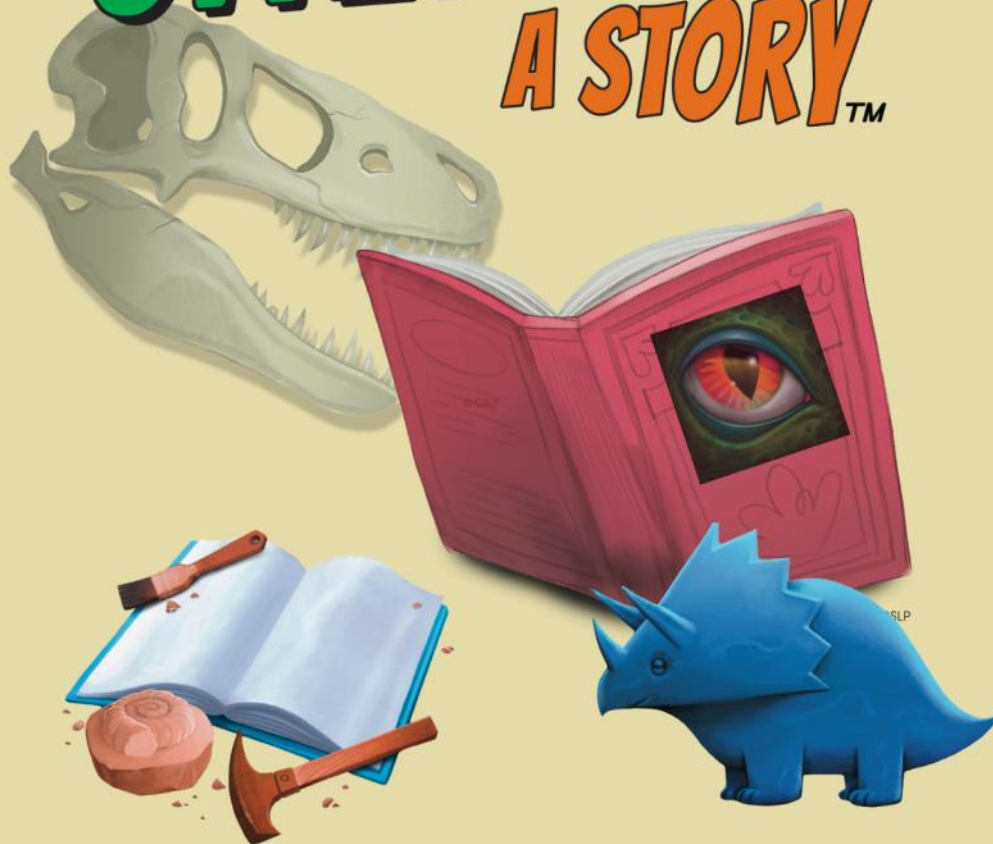

Whether you enjoy digging into a good book, uncovering hidden meanings, or exploring the past, Unearth a Story underscores the joy of discovery that reading brings.

The Forsyth County Public Library has a countless number of stories to discover within our walls, on our shelves, and through the programs and services we offer to our communities. We hope you'll learn something new about yourself, your community, and your library this summer.

Summer Reading kicks off on Friday, June 5 with a party at Forsyth County Central Library (see page 24 for details) and runs through Friday, July 31.
