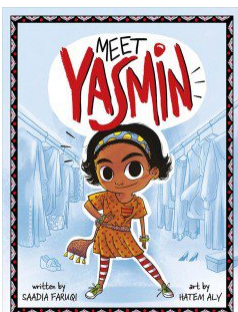

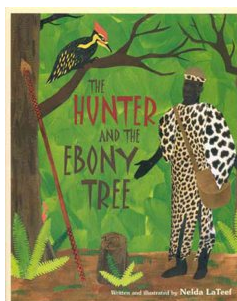


Summer Reads for 1st and 2nd Grades



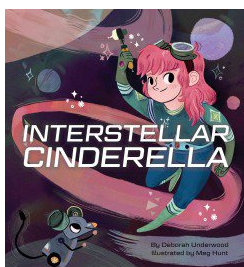
Meet Yasmin! by Saadia Faruqi

Pakistani American second grader Yasmin learns to cope with the small problems of school and home, while gaining confidence in her own skills and creative abilities.



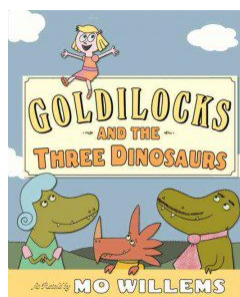
The Hunter and the Ebony Tree by Nelda LaTeef

Interstellar Cinderella by Deborah Underwood

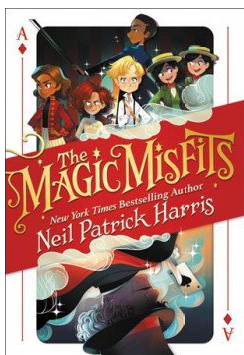

Goldilocks and the Three Dinosaurs by Mo Willems

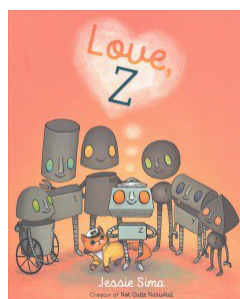
