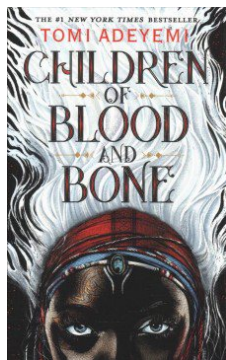

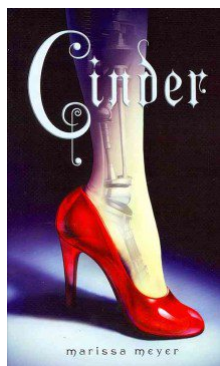


## Summer Reading 2020 Recommendations for Teens

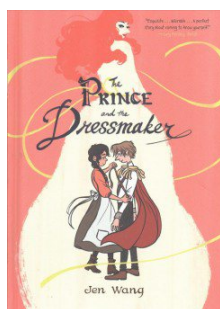


### Children of Blood and Bone

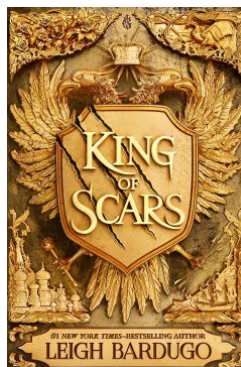


**Cinder**

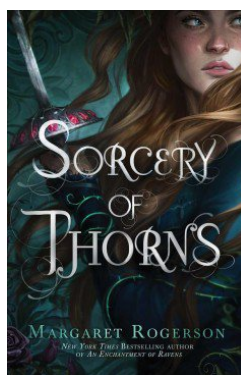


**The Prince and the Dressmaker**

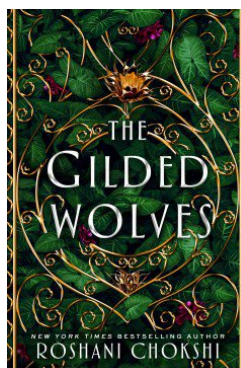
dressmaker who knows his secret at the same time his royal parents begin searching for a traditional bride for him to marry.
