There are currently three indoor facilities open for reservation across all county parks. One is Woodland Hall, which is located at Triad Park. The other two are located at Tanglewood Park, Red Barn and Walnut Hall. These facilities are perfect for indoor events like weddings, birthday parties, baby showers, etc.

County Spotlight — Mt. Pleasant Church

The popular Mt. Pleasant Church at Tanglewood Park is now back OPEN for Reservations starting this month. The Church is an indoor ceremony only facility. Capacity for the facility is 85 people.

The Church has been closed for the better part of 2 years due to construction of the new Golf Clubhouse. With construction complete, we are now back open for all types of ceremonies.

Pricing for the Church is \$200 for a weekday (Mon-Thu) and \$275 for a weekend day (Fri-Sun)

Tanglewood Park RV Campground season is almost back in full swing. The 2026 campground season is from March 1st – December 6th. There are 44 sites, and each site has full hookup with 20/30/50 amp plug in. The campground also features a volleyball course, horseshoe pits, small soccer field, fire pits, and a picnic shelter available for reservation.

Come enjoy Tanglewood Park from a different experience by staying on site. There are plenty of activities to do at the park and around the Clemmons area. Walk the miles of paved or natural surface trails, play a round of golf at one of our courses, or visit our Aquatic Center (Memorial Day-Labor Day).
