**11/8/2016** - Parks and Recreation facilities bonds, including \$5 million for MultiUse Agricultural Event Center, is approved by voters by a margin of 71% 'For' to 29% 'Against'

9/16/21 - Public input report provided to Board of County Commissioners

**10/2021** - Board of Commissioners direct staff to consider alternative location other than Tanglewood site

# 2022:

**2/3/22** - Staff present Multi-Use Agricultural Event Center project at Rolling Hill Drive Property to Tobaccoville Council at their regular meeting

**2/15/22** - Notice of Public Meetings (Print Media, Website, Social Media, Email blasts)

**3/15/22 and 3/30/22** - Public input sessions held at Tobaccoville Community Center on Rolling Hills site

- 3/15/22 4/30/22 Online survey available for public input on Rolling Hills site
- **5/26/22** Staff present Multi-Use Agricultural Event Center project updates to Board of County Commissioners
- 9/22/22 RFQ issued to select design-builder
- **10/22/22** RFQ responses received from Frank L Blum, Davie Construction, IL Long Construction, and Shelco
- **11/22/22** Selection committee recommends Shelco as the best qualified firm for the project.
- **12/1/22** Board of Commissioners selects and awards contract to Shelco to provide design-build services for the design phase of the project for an amount not to exceed \$874,000.

#### 2023:

- 3/2023 Final agreement drafted and entered into contract approval system
- 5/2023- Contract for design phase services is executed
- 6/2023 Design Phase services begin
- **8/2023** Schematic budget presented
- 12/2023 Design Development budget presented

#### 2024:

- **1/2024** Guaranteed Maximum Price for grading phase presented by Shelco; facility design continued.
- **2/2024** Board of Commissioners accept GMP for grading phase and authorize execution of the design-build amendment for the grading phase.
- 5/10/24 Notice to Proceed issued for the grading phase of the project.

**5/2024** - Building phase guaranteed maximum price presented by Shelco; Board of Commissioners accepts GMP and authorizes execution of the Design-Build Amendment for the building phase.

**10/2024** - Grading for building pad at subgrade elevation, entrance road at subgrade elevation, formal groundbreaking ceremony scheduled.
