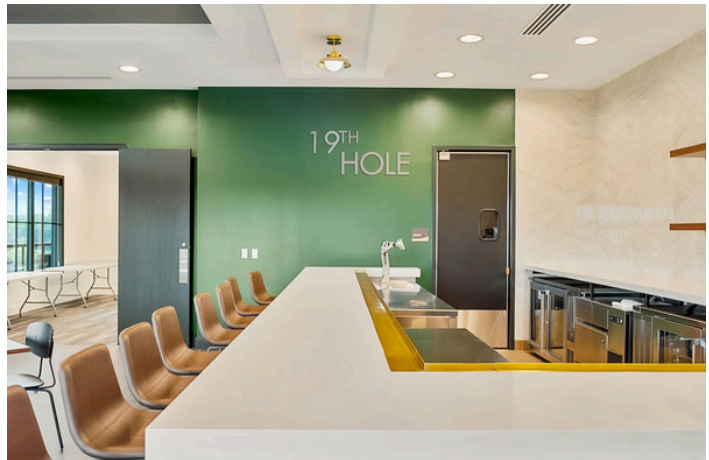

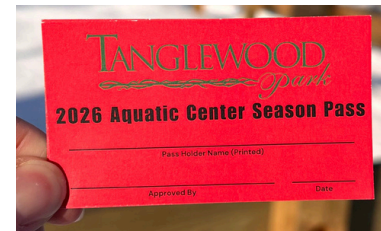


### 2026 Tanglewood Park Aquatic Center Season Passes on sale NOW!

#### Walk MS: Triad Park – April 11th

The annual Walk MS, hosted by the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, will take place on Saturday, April 11, at Triad Park, Shelter 7, at the Carolina Field of Honor (9652 W. Market Street, Kernersville, NC 27284). Participants may choose between a 1-mile or 3-mile route, and all routes are accessible with mobility devices welcome. The event site opens at 8:30 a.m., the ceremony begins at 9:20 a.m., and the walk will officially kick off at 9:30 a.m. We encourage the community to come out, show their support, and take part in this meaningful event benefiting those affected by multiple sclerosis.

#### UpDog International Finals – Tanglewood Park – April 8<sup>th</sup> to April 12<sup>th</sup>

UpDog, an international disc-and-dog sport organization, is bringing its International Finals to Tanglewood Park, offering an exciting opportunity for dogs and their handlers to compete, have fun, and showcase their skills. Designed to encourage play, achievement, and growth, UpDog’s unique games allow teams of all experience levels to work toward their personal bests while enjoying time together. The multi-day event will feature a variety of competitions throughout the week, including Far Out and FunKey on Wednesday; Boom, 7Up, and Throw N Go on Thursday; Freestyle Performance Teams (1–65), Greedy, and Spaced Out on Friday; and Freestyle Performance Teams (65–130), Fireball, and Four Way Play on Saturday. This high-energy event celebrates athleticism, teamwork, and the special bond between dogs and their people.

Walk the miles of paved or natural surface trails, play a round of golf at one of our courses, or visit our Aquatic Center (Memorial Day-Labor Day).
