Department Updates

Tanglewood Park Clubhouse Ribbon Cutting

Commissioners and state elected officials cut the ribbon on the Tanglewood Park Clubhouse on October 27th.

The new clubhouse is a project from the 2016 Forsyth County voter-approved Parks & Recreation Bond, which was made possible by additional state money. It replaces the previous clubhouse, which was built in 1972-73 to host the 1974 PGA Championship.

The new 10,000 square foot clubhouse is designed to be smaller and more efficient than the old one. The new building includes a 1,000-foot ADA accessible Pro Shop, the 19th Hole grill and bar with a covered patio seating overlooking the golf course, several trophy cabinets with golf memorabilia, meeting rooms and event spaces that will be available for the public, and a cart basement that can hold all of Tanglewood's 146 golf carts.

Golf operations officially moved into the building on Sept. 9, a little more than 16 months after construction began. The 19th Hole and event spaces will open at a later date.



2025 Festival of Lights Season

Forsyth County's Tanglewood Park is all geared up for its 34th season of Festival of Lights. Sponsored by Le Bleu Corporation, Festival of Lights is one of the top holiday traditions in the Triad! There's plenty for everyone at Tanglewood Park Festival of Lights. The show will run from November 14th - January 1st, open nightly from 6 - 11pm!
